Soldiers need £6,000 pay rise, say Liberal Democrats

The most junior ranks of the armed forces should get a £6,000 pay rise to boost morale, the Liberal Democrats said. Other privates and lance corporals should get an average salary increase of at least £3,000, with an extra £1,000 for higher non-commissioned officer ranks, the party said.
